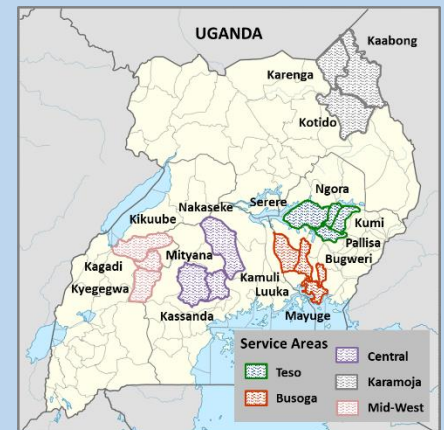

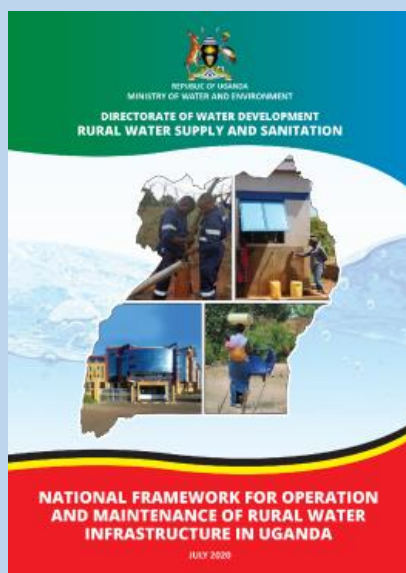


Progress to SDG 6.1: Quarterly Reports
